

Restriction of Use of Hazardous Substances (RoHS)

Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 of 31 March 2015 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of restricted substances

Dwyer Instruments, Inc. certifies that to the best of its knowledge the Series CDTA Communicating Carbon Dioxide Detector meets the substance restrictions of the European Union's Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment Annex II, as modified by Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863.
